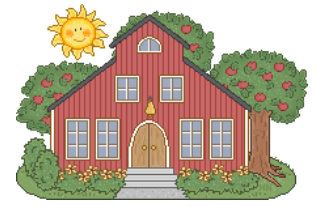

Are You Moving?

As we continue the task of developing class lists for the 2011-12 school year, it is very important for us to know of students who will be moving out of the district during the summer. If your family will be moving within the Waunakee district, per school board policy #431, please provide a proof of residency document such as a utility bill, lease agreement or signed purchase agreement. Also, if your child will be attending another school next fall, i.e. St. John's, Madison Country Day School, etc., please make sure to let us know and complete an Authorization to Obtain and Disclose Information Form. We must have this signed form on file in order to provide information about your child to their new school. Please let us know ASAP. Your cooperation is appreciated!

School Supply Kits Option

We are offering school supply prepackaged kits as a service to our busy families. This is not a fundraiser. Parents have the opportunity to order online on the Arboretum website. The packets will be ordered from School Pak, a company which packages your child's school supplies in a personalized box at a reasonable cost. 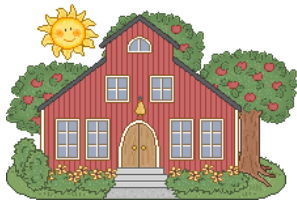

The summer school office is located in the lower level of the Teaching and Learning Center administration building located between the high school and the public library. Want to help your child get familiar with the summer school buildings and find his/her classrooms prior to the start of summer school? We invite you and your child to take a self-guided tour through the schools. Maps will be available and classroom doors will be labeled. Summer school staff will not be present.

Transportation - to locations other than the home address

For safety reasons, pick-up or drop-off locations other than home must be requested in writing by parents/guardians via the *Request for Alternate Pick up/Drop off form* available on the summer school website under Transportation. This request must be submitted to the bus contractor before the routes are finalized for the summer session. Bus routes and pick-up/drop-off locations will not change during the first week of the summer sessions.

Alternate Bus Requests for Session 1 only or Sessions 1 & 2 - **Due Friday, June 10, 2011**

Requests received between June 11th, & June 24th will not begin until June 27th.

Alternate Bus Requests for Session 2 only - **Due Friday, July 1, 2011**

Requests received between July 2nd, & July 15th will not begin until July 18th.

Student attendance is taken during summer school. If your child will miss *any class(es) for any reason*, please contact the school your child is attending. If your child is absent without notice, the summer school attendance secretary will contact you to confirm their absence.
