What's New?

Continued foundation work is wrapping up, while the geothermal bore drilling is moving along as well. As of September 11th, we are approaching the halfway mark with 35 of 90 bores completed. The geothermal pit was waterproofed and the elevator pit walls are set to get poured next week. The rear parking lots were established along with the bus lines, and some pipes are being installed for sanitary sewer and storm water drainage.
