ANNUAL NOTICE OF PROGRAMS FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

The school district provides programs for students with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) who meet specific requirements. The parents/guardians of English Learners participating in a language instruction program shall be notified, no later than 30 days after the beginning of the school year, of the following: (1) Placement and reason why their child was identified as LEP, (2) Child's academic achievement level and level of English proficiency (including method of measurement), (3) The methods used for language instruction, (4) How the language program will meet the child's instructional needs, (5) How the program will help the child to learn English and meet the academic standards for promotion or graduation, (6) The exit requirements for the language program, (7) When applicable, how the program meets Individual Education Plan (IEP) goals, and (8) An explanation of parental rights, including the parent's right to enroll or remove a child from the language instruction program (ESSA 20 U.S.C. § 6312 (e))
