1. Public input on agenda items - none

- 2. Testing & Assessment Booklet- Reviewed the 200708 Testing & Assessment Mike reviewed how the staff will use the results to improve student performance. The results of Advanced Placement (AP) & ACT testing will be provided in late August. The departments will do an item results to ascertain of WKCE if  ${f there}$ curriculum/instructional modifications on any areas of concern. minor changes will be made: p. 6 "Fall 2007"; p. 12 provide AYP explanation; and p. 14 note that the recommended action plans comes directly from our district School Improvement Institute. The information in the booklet will be discussed at the full BOE meeting on Monday; distribute to building coordinators & department chairs; and download to the district web site for public review.
- 3. <u>Human Growth & Development Handbook</u>-Shared the progress on various HGD issues but will need more time to have K-12 & community consensus on the document. Probably ready in late fall for full BOE review/approval.
- 4. Dane County Youth Assessment Survey-Shelley Weiss & Brian Kersten presented information on the district possibly using this survey. Craig Wille was not able to attend meeting but he will be involved on this review. Presently it is administered in all Dane Co. schools but De Forest & Waunakee. Many fine questions were raised such as: can we administer it in only a few grades 7-12 (yes); what type of parent consent (active consent); how to administer test (MS through homerooms & HS would need further investigation); can we eliminate some questions from the survey (yes, but to what degree?); when would a recommendation regarding administration of the survey be needed (the time has passed for 08-09 any decision would be for 09-10); how would the results be used (comparisons to other Dane Co. schools and justifications for grants & curriculum changes); what is the cost

(no cost); do we have any other similar survey (we have administered other like surveys (40 Assets, Teen Screen & local surveys.

Motion by Bambi, second Julie to support the review of various school climate surveys (Dane County Youth Assessment, Teen Screen & local surveys), share these surveys with Human Growth & Development Committee members, parents groups, staff and others. Bring forward a recommendation to the Curriculum Committee for action this fall. Motion passed 3-0.

- 5. Grading practices (Ken O'Connor and staff inservice plans for 08-09) Committee discussed the August 27 inservice (Ken O'Connor) and staff training on grading practices in 2008-09.
- 6. Math placement-Distributed a rough draft of the Algebra benchmarks and student placement criteria.
- 7. Tentative List of Curriculum reports to BOE 2008-09 Minor revision Social Studies will replace LMTC in April 2009.
- 8. Eclipse (Curriculum structuring) will reschedule at another curriculum mtg.
