The School Board ("Board" or "Board of Education") of the Wa unakee Community School District is comprised of seven (7) Board members. Board members are public officials who are elected or a ppointed to office asprovided under state law.

Applic able law definesthe scope of the Board's duties, powers, a nd authority. State law expressly provides that the statutory duties and powers of school boards shall be broadly construed to authorize any school board action that is within the comprehensive meaning of the terms of the duties and powers, if the action is not prohibited by the laws of the federal govemment or by the laws of this state. Further, one of the express statutory powers of the Board is the powerdo all things reasonable to promote the cause of education.
