

Minutes of Annual Meeting

The Board of Education Waunakee Community School District

An Annual Meeting of the Board of Education of Waunakee Community School District was held Monday, October 19, 2020, beginning at 7:00 PM in the Waunakee Community School District, 905 Bethel Circle, Waunakee, WI 53597.

Randy Guttenberg called the district budget hearing and annual meeting to order at 7:02 PM.

Present: Mr. Brandt, Mr. Boetcher, Ms. Ensign, Ms. Engebretson, Mr. Heinemann, Mr. Hetzel, Mr. Hoefler.

I. Elect Chairperson to Conduct Budget Hearing and the Annual Meeting

Mr. Guttenberg asked for nominations for the selection of a chairperson to conduct the budget hearing and annual meeting. A motion was made by Brandt, Second by Boetcher to nominate Heinemann to serve as chairperson for the meeting. Heinemann was elected chairperson of the 2020 Annual Meeting unanimously on a voice vote. (7-0) 2020

II. Reading of the Official Notice of the Budget Hearing and the Annual Meeting -Judith Engebretson

III. Budget Summary & District Goals Report - District Administrator Randy Guttenberg turned this portion of the meeting over to the Executive Director of Operations, Steve Summers, who attended this meeting via zoom. Steve Summers reviewed the annual meeting report. Randy Guttenberg reviewed the district goals and summarized what the district has done and what will be done in the future. Randy Guttenberg also thanked the community for their support.

IV. Discussion and Review of Budget - Steve Summers shared information in review of the budget.
