

Galin Scholars works to increase access to college preparation for students with strong academic potential who are from low-to-middle income families and from demographic groups underrepresented in college.

Our program helps students and their families to confidently navigate the college preparation process and to find the colleges that are a best fit for each student. This opportunity is provided at no cost to our scholars who begin work with us before their junior year of high school.

ACT Preparation

Weekly tutoring sessions to help each scholar improve their test score

College Advising

Individual guidance to research college options and to develop a plan for applying

Academic tutoring

Tutoring for specific academic subjects as needed

Extracurriculars

Financial support or connections to academic, art, or athletic opportunities

Support

Guidance for students and their families in preparing for and applying to college

Who should apply?

High-achieving, college-bound students who:

- are in 10th grade in a high school in Dane County, WI.
- have an unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- are from a household with an annual income less than \$90,000
- are from demographic groups underrepresented in college, including (but not limited to): race/ethnicity; income; first generation to go to college; gender identity; from a rural community; who are experiencing a significant family hardship
- are motivated to improve their academic and study skills and to participate in a process to find a best fit college.

Application/nomination

Students can submit an application directly to Galin Scholars. Teachers, counselors, mentors, or family members can submit a nomination form and students will be sent information about applying.
